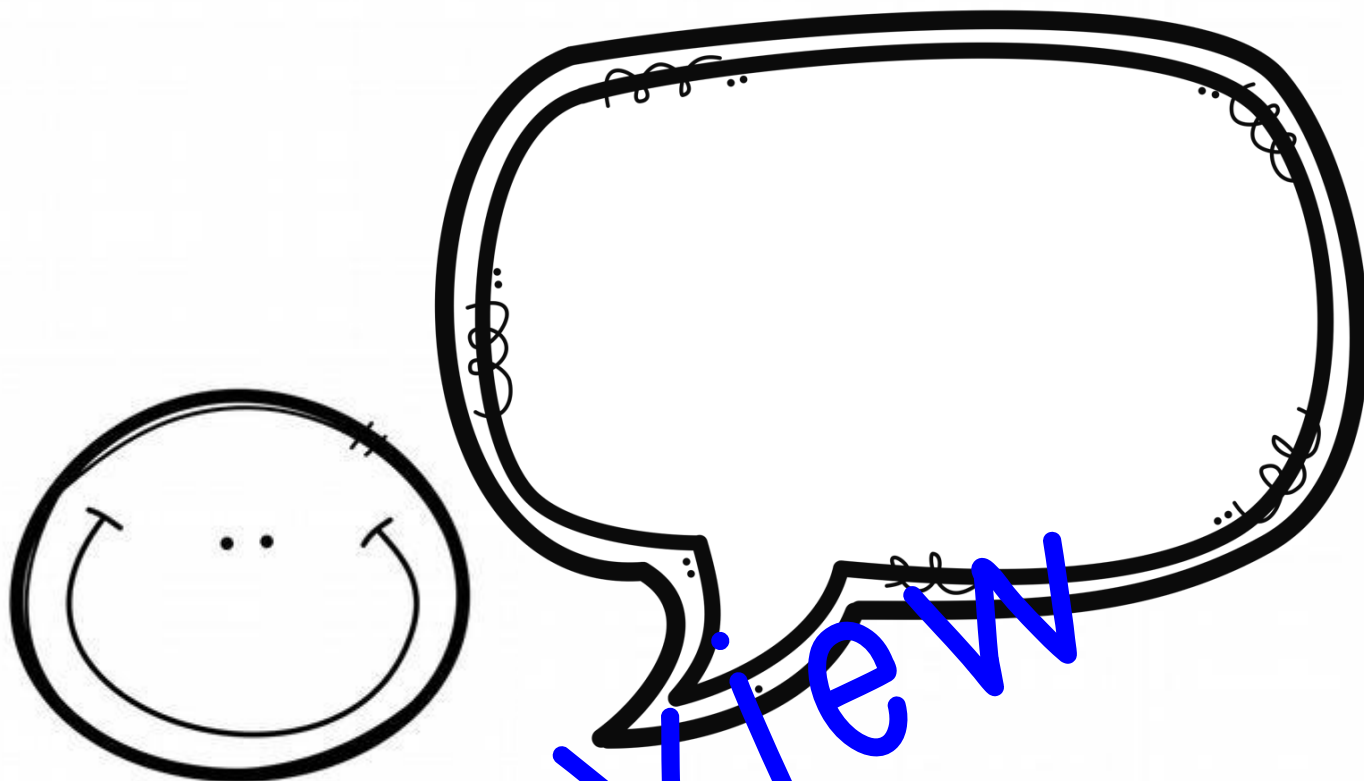

Teaching Notes!

-This pack includes 10 common character/ personality traits to explore and discuss with your students. You can use the ones that best fit the needs of your students. I have also included a separate set of response pages with another line size, as well as a more open ended response template. The color posters at the end of the pack are great for displays as well!

- I always begin by distinguishing between physical and personality traits. To begin, I have students draw a self portrait on a large piece of white construction paper. I have them label some of their physical traits (hair color, eye color etc). I keep these aside until we have completed our study of personality traits.

-Then I introduce personality traits (there are posters to help with this). Print a booklet or just the pages you'll need/want for student response. I like to launch each of these with a read aloud (see note/link below!). Then read the definition page, color the picture, and discuss how the picture shows the character/personality trait we are discussing. Then students write and draw to tell what they can say and do in order to show each of those character/personality traits.

-At the end of the unit, have students write three (or more) personality traits they have, one in each heart. I give them the option of adding some other traits (funny, smart etc.) as long as they're personality traits. They can then cut and glue the hearts onto their self portrait.
